NOTICE OF RACE FOR 2017 HARTLEY TS16 NSW /ACT CHAMPIONSHIP

The Drummoyne Sailing Club (DSC) in conjunction with the NSW & ACT Division of the Hartley TS16 Association of Australia will conduct this regatta from 14th to 16th April 2017 inclusive on the Parramatta River at Drummoyne NSW.

1. RULES:

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 and the Regulations of Maritime NSW.
- 1.2 The YA Special Regulations Part 2 for Off the Beach Boats will apply to this regatta.
- 1.3 Except in emergencies during a race, only the helmsperson nominated on the Entry Form shall act as helmsperson during the races. Crew shall be nominated on the Entry Form. If more than one crew is nominated, the races in which each crew member will sail shall be nominated on the Entry Form. Approval for changes to the nominated crew arrangements may be given by the Race Committee if a written request is submitted to them at the first reasonable opportunity and they believe that the proposed changes do not appear to provide a competitive advantage and that there is a good reason for them.
- 1.4 Substitution of damaged or lost equipment will not be allowed unless authorized by the Race Committee. Requests for substitution shall be made in writing at the first reasonable opportunity.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

- 2.1 The championship regatta for outright places is open to boats holding current "A" class registration with the Hartley TS16 Association of Australia Inc. Proof of registration may be required.
- 2.2 Boats not holding "A" class registration, but registered with the Hartley TS16 Association of Australia, may enter in the handicap section only, at the discretion of the Organizing Authority, providing such boats conform in general with the Hartley TS16 plans and in detail with the Safety Regulations for Organised Racing in Protected Waters of the AUSTRALIAN HARTLEY TS16 SAFETY MANUAL. Boats entered in this category will not be eligible for championship places or for trophies awarded for outright places.
- 2.3 Helmspersons shall be financial members of the Hartley TS16 Association of Australia Inc. Proof of membership may be required.

2.4 Eligible boats may enter, using the attached Entry Form, which shall be lodged with:

by last mail on 7th April 2017, with the required fee (see Section 2.5 and 2.6).

Late entries will be accepted up to 1200hrs on 14th April 2017 at the Race Office at DSC.

- 2.5 The fee for entries received by 7th April 2017 will be \$20 per boat.
- 2.6 Fees received after 7th April will be \$50 per boat
- 2.7 The NSW & ACT Division of the Hartley TS16 Association of Australia Inc. and the Drummoyne Sailing Club reserve the right to refuse an entry.

3. SCHEDULE:

- 3.1 Entrants shall register at the Race Office in DSC clubhouse on arrival and no later than 1200 hours on 14th April 2017.

4. RACING AREA, COURSES AND SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Racing will take place on Parramatta River in the vicinity of the DSC clubhouse. Courses will be described in the Sailing Instructions, which will be available at registration.

5. SCORING AND PRIZES

- 5.1 The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply. Three races must be completed to constitute a series. If four or fewer races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of its race scores. This changes RRS Rule A2.
- 5.3 Handicaps will be back calculated from the results of the first three heats and then applied to all races.

6. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

7. PRIZES

- 7.1 Trophies/Prizes will be awarded to first through to fifth places for both outright and handicap series. Other prizes may be awarded.
- 7.2 No boat shall be eligible for more than one prize in the outright and handicap sections. If a boat would, on initial calculations, score a prize in both sections, it will be given the choice of these prizes and will be ineligible for prizes in the other section.
- 7.3 Trophies, as per the Sailing Instructions, will be awarded at a presentation ceremony as soon as practicable after the last race.

8. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk; see RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after this regatta.

9. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10,000,000 per event or the equivalent.
