# 2018 – 2019 Drummoyne Sailing Club, Juniors Division Notice of Race (NoR)

Sunday September 9, 2018 – Sunday April 14, 2019 Organising Authority: Drummoyne Sailing Club



#### 1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the 2017 – 2020 Racing Rules of Sailing as amended by the prescriptions and special regulations of Australian Sailing (AS), the current class rules, this notice of race and the Sailing Instructions.

## 2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1. The event is open to the following classes: Sabot 1-Up, Sabot 2-Up, Flying 11, Laser 4.7 and Cherub
- 2.2. Further classes may apply in writing to the Race Committee to be included
- 2.3. The Juniors will start and finish OK Dinghies and Historical Skiffs who are responsible for their own division
- 2.4. To participate in a race series and be eligible for points, trophies & travel monies, a boat, the skipper and crew must be registered and therefore listed as financial members for the current season in the Drummoyne Sailing Club (DSC) race registration system.
- 2.5. Any crew member who has sailed at the DSC for more than 3 races is required to join DSC and register as a crew using the Drummoyne Sailing Club race registration system.
- 2.6. The DSC race registration system for the 2018-19 sailing season will be available online at <a href="https://www.drummoynesailingclub.com.au/sailing/juniors.html">https://www.drummoynesailingclub.com.au/sailing/juniors.html</a>
- 2.7. Change of crew must be notified to the Race Committee in writing prior to the race.

#### 3. Calendar

## 4. Measurement

Each boat shall hold a valid measurement certificate for the duration of the sailing season. This must be available for the Race Committee on request.

# 5. Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be available on the DSC website prior to the first race.

#### 7. Scoring

Scoring will be outlined in the Sailing Instructions.

# 8. Radio Communication

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

## 9. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## 10. Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of AUD \$10,000,000 per incident or the equivalent for the duration of the sailing season
