# **NOTICE OF RACE**

## **2020-2021 Sprint Series**

### **1. Invitation**

1.1 The Drummoyne Sailing Club (DSC) invites entries to owners of eligible boats to enter the '2020-2021 Sprint Series'.

### **2. Rules**

2.1 Racing will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017 -2020 ("RRS") of World Sailing (WS), and the Special Regulationsof Australian Sailing (AS). These may be amended by the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

### **3. Eligibility & Entry**

3.1 Entry is open to mono hull sailing yachts with length overall from 6m to 11m or at the Race Committee's discretion.

3.2 Yachts must hold a Category 7 Equipment Audit Form.

3.3 Hartley TS 16s.

3.4 Entry is free for boats who paid 2020-2021 race entry fees.

### **4. Schedule**

4.1 Racing is held over 2 non-consecutive days as shown in the DSC Website Sailing Calendar.

4.2 Race days are scheduled for Saturday 19th December 2020 & Saturday 23rd January 2021.

### **5. Divisions and Classes**

5.1 Yacht Divisions will be determined by the number of entries received.

5.2 Hartley TS 16s.

### **6. Courses**

6.1 The courses shall be detailed in the 2020-2021 Sprint Series Sailing Instructions.

### **7. Racing Area**

7.1 The racing area will be the Parramatta River bounded by Gladesville Bridge, Iron Cove Bridge and Sydney Harbour Bridge.

### **8. Handicaps & Scoring**

8.1 The PHS Handicap system will be used to score a boat's result and adjust her handicap.

8.2 A boats series score will be the total of her race scores with no excluded scores.

8.3 A number of races required to constitute a series is 3.

8.4 A boats assigned handicap will not be cause for protest or redress.

### 9. Race Results and Prizes

- 9.1 The provisional results of each race will be announced at DSC after each race day. Competitors must be present to be eligible for a prize.
- 9.2 Prizes will be awarded, 1st, 2nd & 3rd place overall handicap in each Division and Class, on race day number 1 and race day number 2. Prizes will also be awarded to 1st, 2nd & 3rd placing in each Division and Class for the Series Pointscore overall Handicap.
- 9.3 Results will also be posted on DSC website usually within 48 hours of any race day at [www.dsc.org.au](http://www.dsc.org.au) subject to protest.
- 9.4 Major Prize, weekend at **The Old Bottleshop - Currarong**. \*Conditions Apply.

# SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

## 2020-2021 Sprint Series

### 1. Rules

- 1.1 The races will be governed by the rules, as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017 - 2020 ("RRS") of World Sailing (WS), and the Special Regulations and prescriptions of Australian Sailing (AS). These may be amended by the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions. The Organising Authority is the Drummoynes Sailing Club. ("DSC").

### 2. Schedule of Races & Classes

- 2.1 Racing is held over 2 non-consecutive days as shown in the DSC Website Sailing Calendar.
- 2.2 The following classes will be sailed:
- Yachts
  - Hartley TS 16s
- 2.3 There are up to 5 Handicap Races scheduled for each race day.
- 2.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal of the first race of each race day is 1255hrs .
- 2.5 When more than one race will be held on the same day, the warning signal for each succeeding race will be made as soon as practicable after the finish of the previous race.

### 3. Class Flags

- 3.1 The class flags will be as follows:

Class	Flag
Yachts	Numeral Pennant 1
Hartley TS 16s	TS 16 Class Flag

### 4. Warning Signals and Start Time

- 4.1 Warning signals will be as follows:

Class	Warning Signal	Start Time
Yachts	1255	1300
Hartley TS 16s	1300	1305

### 5. The Courses

- 5.1 The courses are shown in Appendix A1.
- 5.2 The course to be sailed will be indicated by the number displayed on the start boat.

### **6. The Start**

- 6.1 The starting line will be between the flagstaff on the Committee Boat at the starboard end and an orange flag at the port end.
- 6.2 Boats whose starting signal has not been made shall keep clear of the start line and other boats starting. Boats failing to observe this instruction may be disqualified by the Race Committee without a hearing.

### **7. The Finish**

- 7.1 The finishing line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the Race Committee boat and the course side of the finish mark at the other end. See course diagrams for details

### **8. Time Limits**

- 8.1 The time limit for each race will be 60 minutes.
- 8.2 Boats failing to finish within 20 minutes after the first boat finishes will be scored DNF without a hearing.
- 8.3 No races will be started after 1700 hours.

### **9. Penalty System**

- 8.1 The racing rules will be modified in accordance with Rule 86 as follows: Rule 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required. This changes General Conditions of Racing 7.18

### **10. Scoring**

- 10.1 The PHS Handicap system will be used to score a boat's result and adjust her handicap.
- 10.2 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores with no excluded scores.
- 10.3 The number of races required to constitute a series is 3.

### **11. Prizes**

- 11.1 Prizes will be presented to 1st, 2nd & 3rd place-getters overall in each Division and Class after each race day.
- 11.2 Major Prize, weekend at The Old Bottleshop - Currarong. \*Conditions Apply.
- 11.3 Major prize will be drawn from the "barrel." Names of race entries for each race for each division and class will have one entry in the barrel. Third place in a race for each division allows one extra name in the barrel. Second place in a race for each division allows two extra names in the barrel. First place in a race for each division allows three extra names in the barrel.
