

# Amendment to Sailing Instructions

Drummoyne Sailing Club 2021-2022 Season

The following amendment to the Sailing Instructions for the 2021-2022 DSC sailing season shall apply effective 12/2/2022. Section 17, Average Points, shall be replaced with the following:

## 17. Average Points

17.1 Average points may be awarded for boats that are unable to sail in a race due to the following reasons:

- a) representation of the club at a recognised event or regatta approved by the race committee
- b) at the request of the race committee, manning a support boat, committee boat, or otherwise providing operation race support

17.2 Average points may be awarded to boats for other reasons, as determined by the policy of the Race Committee, and provided:

- a) The policy has been clearly communicated to all relevant competitors
- b) The policy is within the principles of fair sailing as outlined in RRS 2

17.3 Application for average points must be made in writing to the race committee prior to the event, or as soon as reasonably practical. Approval of average points is subject to the discretion of the race committee and is not subject to protest or redress. This amends RRS 60.1 (a) and (b), and 63.1

17.4 Any changes to this section (SI 17) or to policy as outlined in SI 17.2, may be applied retroactively.

17.5 Average points will be calculated from the boat's average results to the impacted race date of the request.

17.6 Average points will not be awarded for Club Championship races (unless as the result of a scoring redress, RRS Appendix A).
